Maths

We will be exploring, finding and making patterns. We will be walking and the environment and finding patterns in nature, matching patterns on socks and making repeating patterns with objects. This will be one step pattern. We will continue to count to 10 everyday and counting a set of objects as we are playing.

Communication, Language and Literacy

Listening with increased attention and focus, for longer periods. Follow instructions with 2 parts. Understanding positional language, Use a simple sentence when speaking. Use new vocabulary in different contexts. Use a question when talking with others.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Explore the feelings of happy, sand and angry. Discuss Mother's Day; What is special about our Mums/carers? How do they look after us? What kind thing could we do to show our Mums /carers how much we love them? Think about how it's OK that we're not all the same.; it's OK to be different. Explore healthy eating and exercise and how to look after our bodies and keep safe.

Phonics

We are continuing to explore environmental sounds and learning how to make different sounds with our bodies. We are singing lots of nursery rhymes to help us hear rhyming words.


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Parent and Carer Survey
