Phonics

We use the Read Write Inc scheme (RWI) to teach phonics throughout school.

The children start by learning sounds. It is important that they learn to pronounce the sound correctly, we call these pure sounds.

They then learn to blend these sounds together e.g. c-a-t, cat. We call this 'Fred Talk'

At the same time, the children learn how to form the letter that represents this sound.

They then begin to segment (spell) and write these words using the letters they have learnt. We use 'Fred F
