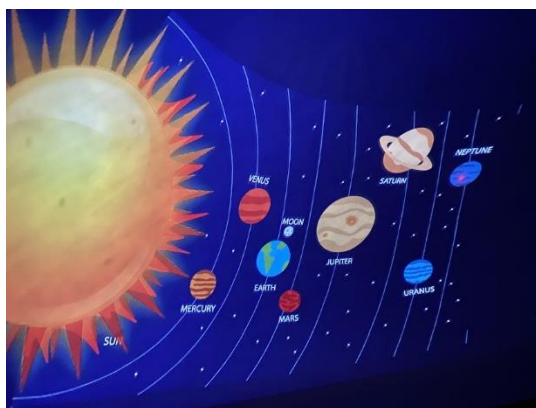
### **Arbor Parent Portal**
