## EYFS Wise Owls Drop In

Dear Parent/Carers,

We are continuing to work with BHT who provide support for children and families experiencing difficulties with Speech, Language and Communication Needs. A Language Development Worker will be coming into school **weekly on a Thursday from 8:45-9:45am** to offer a drop-in for parents who are concerned about their child and hoping to seek advice.

The Wise Owl drop-in sessions are for parents and carers with children in **Nursery and/or Reception**.

Things you may wish to discuss include:

- attention and listening difficulties
- delayed language, unclear speech
- difficulties with understanding.

The Language Development Worker will provide support and strategies and signpost to other programmes. It is advised that the family carry out the strategies suggested for at least 3 weeks. If the Language Development Worker feels the child would benefit from Owlets and they are under the age of 4, they will offer a referral into the Owlets group. Further information is available here:
