Swimming is an essential life skill and part of the core physical education programme. We kindly ask that you ensure your child brings their swimming kit to school on the designated days so they can continue to benefit from these lessons.

Should there be any specific reasons, such as a medical condition, that prevents your child from participating, please provide a doctor's note so we can make the necessary arrangements.
