Year 3 Road safety Awareness

Dear Parents and Carers,

Over 200 children are seriously hurt and injured on Bradford and District roads every year. It is vitally important that young people develop skills to use the roads and travel safely.

On either **Tuesday 6th or Wednesday 7th May 2025**, your child will participate in a practical pedestrian training session where they will learn about safe practices when crossing roads. We will let you know closer to the time which date your child will participate on. This will be done **outside of the school grounds** using the pavements and roads surrounding the school perimeter.

Children will be led by the Road Safety team, and supported by familiar staff from the school. Your child will work within a small group. Prior to their practical session they will take part in a short classroom activity, led by their teacher to support their understanding of the activity.
