Dear Parents/Carers,

As you are aware, swimming sessions and trips to ZEN came to an end in Spring 2 with the view to widen the offer for all pupils accessing the Resourced Provision. We have evaluated the needs of the pupils and considered what learning opportunities would best support their wider understanding of the world around them, starting first and foremost within the local community.

With this in mind, we have planned a sequence of life skill lessons and practical application opportunities focussed on road safety, stranger danger, animal danger and sun safety. Once per week, we would be hoping to take your child out within the local community, in high adult:low pupil ratio numbers, to develop their understanding of how to walk along the pavements, how to cross the road, how to manage potential hazards with the aim of building up to a trip to Morrisons to buy ingredients for a lesson.

We would like to reassure you that thorough risk assessments have been completed, including the individual pupils risk assessments you have already signed, and we will be taking every individual need into account prior to leaving school grounds.
