Here are a few reminders for you:

Uniform

Please ensure your child comes to school in the correct school uniform each day. Our uniform helps foster a sense of belonging and pride in our school community.

On PE days your child can come to school wearing their PE kit. This consists of:

- Plain white t shirt (not football shirts)
- Black shorts/jogging bottoms/leggings
- School hoodie or a plain black hoodie/zip up jumper
- Trainers

Non PE day uniform consists of:

- Grey trousers/skirt
- White polo neck t shirt
- Purple jumper (Years Reception -Year 5)
- Black jumper (Year 6 only)
- Plain black school shoes or plain black trainers (no patterns or different coloured soles)

Polite reminder that hoodie's and trainers should be worn on a PE day **only**.

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Pick Up Points

For a smooth and safe end to the school day:

Early Years	Pick up points
Reception Ducklings Reception Elephants	Double doors at the front of the Early Years building (where you drop them off)
Year 1	Key Stage 1 playground- Year 1 doors
Year 2	Key Stage 1 playground- by the tyres
Year 5	Key Stage 1 playground- near the pirate ship
Year 3	Key Stage 2 playground- by the railings on entering the playground
Year 4	Key Stage 2 playground- near the games fenced area (MUGA)
Year 6	Key Stage 2 playground- near the basketball hoops

If someone else is collecting your child, please let the school office know in advance, they will also require the password.

- Gates open at 8:30am and the school day starts promptly at 8:40am please make sure your child arrives on time.
